COVID-19 SAFETY POLICY

Anyone entering Birchtown Stables, Inc. 115 Birchtown Drive Clifford Twp. PA 18421 must adhere to the 2020 Covid-19 Policy and Rules while on the property. Those admitted and found not in compliance with the rules will be asked to leave the site and will not be allowed re-entry.

Additionally, all Federal, State and local laws that may be applicable at the time of entry must be followed.

-If you are experiencing ANY of the symptoms related to the Covid-19 virus, PLEASE STAY HOME and contact your healthcare professional.

Anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms, has tested positive for COVID-19 within last two weeks, or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks*

Cannot enter the competition grounds.

*Exception: Healthcare personnel who have treated patients using appropriate medical- grade PPE during the course of performing professional duties are exempted from this restriction.

- Birchtown is open only to Essential People only. Trainers, Riders, Grooms, Owners, Competition Staff and Parents attending solely as a minor's guardian.
NO SPECTATORS, NO additional Family or Friends are allowed.
- All participants must provide emergency contact information and sign an updated Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement provided by Birchtown.
- Trainers will be held responsible for their barns and ensuring that those affiliated with their barns adhere to the rules. Please discuss with everyone the importance of following the Birchtown Rules.
- In ALL INDOOR BUILDINGS (Lower Stall Building, Staging Ring, Observation Room, Main Indoor) Please wear mask or face covering (except when mounted on a horse), and maintain a 6-foot distance (one horse's length) from others at all times. A participant cannot be disqualified or penalized for wearing a facemask or face covering while competing.
- There are numerous Hand Sanitizers located throughout the site, please use them frequently.
Please avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Please don't loiter on the grounds unnecessarily before or after showing. In the event of a storm, please shelter in your car/trailer and do no gather in the barn or show building. This is very important for controlling numbers on the show grounds and helping us to ensure social distancing.
